
IPR Report


A one-day workshop on "Plagiarism and protection of copyright under Intellectual property rights" was conducted on 1st may 2021 at 1.00 am in online mode. The workshop was jointly organized by department of Chemistry and internal quality assurance cell. Initially Dr.Avinash Nalawade, NAAC coordinator introduced Dr. Yogesh Desai and told the purpose of the workshop. About 65 student and staff members joined the webinar.

Dr Yogesh Desai Explained the various aspects of intellectual property right. He explained about plagiarism.He told that the minor changes in copied texts comes under plagiarism.He told that plagiarism is a act of stealing another person's intellectual property (IP) which includes ideas, inventions, original works of authorship, words, slogans, designs, proprietary information, etc. Plagiarism is one aspect of intellectual property right. Plagiarism is when you use words, thoughts, or ideas that belong to someone else by citing your sources.

He explained that if anybody copy a section from a textbook into an essay or article without acknowledging it, i.e. making it look like part of my own writing like the rest of the essay or article, this is plagiarism. Intellectual property is about the right to control (and profit from) particular work.

Finally President of the function Dr. R. V. Shejwal give his presidential remarks. Mr. Ninad Kadam IQAC coordinator gave vote of thanks. The function was ended by national anthem.
