






Collaboration and Community Participation:



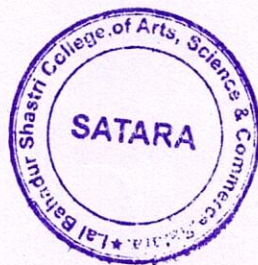

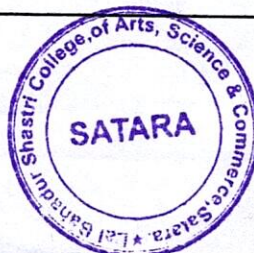
