Excursion report Date:-05/01/2024

As per the curriculum of Shivaji University Kolhapur, P.G. Department of Zoology of Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Arts, Science, and Commerce, Satara organized an excursion for B. Sc. II& III students to a Zoological survey of research, Pune for knowledge of Indian biodiversity & Rajiv Gandhi National Park and Wildlife Research Center, Pune to educate them about the biodiversity that makes up the world.

Objectives of Excursion:

- To know the workings of ZSI visit to ZSI museum.
- To understand the biodiversity of India from experts of ZSI.
- To know the collection and identification process in ZSI.
- To know about animal behavior and characteristics.
- To create awareness about animal behavior, care & conservation.

Zoological Survey of India, Pune:

The Zoological Survey of India (ZSI) was founded in July 1916 by the Ministry, of Forest and Climate Change of the Government of India as a premier Indian organization in zoological research and studies to promote the survey, exploration, and research of the fauna in the country.

The Zoological survey of India, Western Regional Centre is one of the 16 regional centers of ZSI established in 1959 with the objectives of survey and documentation of the faunal diversity of the western region of the country, covering Gujrat, Maharashtra and Karnataka, and goa state and Deccan regions of India.

Scientists at the center have discovered more than 100 species. Field officers of ZSI explained the work of ZSI, flora, and fauna of western ghat, identification process, and recruitment of ZSI in a very detailed manner. The National Zoological Collection is maintained at the center. ZSI maintained a quality museum at their center in which we saw different types of preserved orders of insects:

i)Coleoptera ii) Diptera iii) Hemiptera iv) Hymenoptera v) Mantodea vi) Lepidoptera vii) odonata viii) Neuroptera ix) Thysanura

Other specimens present in the ZSI museum :

Different species of Birds, Pisces, Mammals, Reptiles, Crustaceans. ZSI museum has the Olive ridley turtle, The scaly anteater, and even the nocturnal primate loris in their museum.

Rajiv Gandhi National Park and Wildlife Research Center, Pune :

The Rajiv Gandhi Zoological Park, commonly known as the Rajiv Gandhi Zoo or Katraj Zoo, is located in Katraj, Pune district, Maharashtra. It is managed by the Pune Municipal Corporation. The 130-acre zoo is divided into three parts: an animal orphanage, A snake park, and a zoo, and a 42-acre katraj lake.

The Zoo has a collection of reptiles, mammals and birds. The major attractions among all animals that is the white tiger and the Asiatic lion. Other mammals at the zoo include leopards, sloth bears, sambhar, barking deer, blackbucks, monkeys, and elephants. The Zoo is famous for its large collection of snakes including Indian rock python, cobra, snakes, vipers, Indian crocodile, and Indian star tortoise.

The area of the zoo is very large so we took 3 to 4 hours to fully explore this location. We learned an extensive collection of snakes and reptiles and the 13-foot king cobra was a major attraction among all snakes. The branch of animal care and research organized many programs to educate the public about animals and their behavior. A visit to Rajiv Gandhi National Zoological Park made our day, it was a very exciting and pleasurable experience.
